Kia ora Linton Camp Whanau,

Late last month, the Ministry of Education announced staffing and funding for 2023.

Linton Camp School will get less staffing (which we were expecting) but more funds. We also gained access to the Ministry-funded School Donation Scheme.

Eligible schools can choose to receive \$154.13 (ex gst) per student, per year, if they agree not to charge parents/caregivers for donations, except for overnight camps.

At Linton Camp School we would receive between \$20 000 and \$25 000 per year (depending upon the number of students). Currently our families are asked for a donation of \$75 for one child or \$100 per family. The Donation Scheme would replace this payment expectation.

Being part of the scheme means our school will not be charging for things like bus hire, visiting performers or class trips. However, stationery, camps, yr7&8 Technology fees and sports fees will still be a cost to parents.

Part of the process to join the scheme (or not) is consultation with the parent community.

Could you please take a moment to complete the survey, to let us know what you think. The link was emailed to you earlier this week.

The survey closes on November 01, 2022.
